Biographical Note

Jim Jordan (1886-1951) grew up on a farm in Stanley, Wisconsin, and worked seasonally as a logger in the Chippewa Valley area of Wisconsin in the early 20th century. He later moved to Washington state and worked for the Long-Bell Lumber Company of Longview, Washington, until his death in 1951.
